**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING HURLEY LUCCKESE FOR HIS OUTSTANDING
LEADERSHIP, SERVICE, AND ACHIEVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, Hurley Lucckese, a distinguished senior at Louisa County High School, has demonstrated exceptional leadership, academic excellence, and dedication to his school and community through his involvement in Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA); and

He is also an inductee of the National Honor Society, demonstrating a strong commitment to scholarship, service, character, and leadership both inside and outside the classroom; and

WHEREAS, Hurley credits his success to the lasting influence of his late father, whose strength, integrity, and encouragement continue to inspire him following his passing in December 2025, and to his educator, Mrs. Lohr, whose mentorship and unwavering support have helped shape his leadership journey; and

WHEREAS, Hurley's achievements bring great pride to his family, Louisa County High School, Louisa County Public Schools, and the citizens of Louisa County, serving as an inspiration to future generations of student leaders;
