A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A SAFETY/SPEED STUDY ON ROUTE 656 (CEDAR HILL ROAD) IN THE CUCKOO DISTRICT

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Louisa County Board of Supervisors to protect the health, safety, and welfare of all its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors feel there is a need for appropriate speed signage and reduction on the entirety of Route 656 (Cedar Hill Road), as there appears to be speeds in excess of the current road conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Board feels that the safety on this highway can be significantly improved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 8th day of September 2026, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby requests that the Virginia Department of Transportation conduct a traffic speed/safety study on Route 656 (Cedar Hill Road), as there appears to be speeds in excess of the current road conditions.
