The County Administrator's Report serves to keep the Board informed of ongoing County operations, departmental activities, upcoming events, and significant correspondence received since the previous meeting.

MONTHLY REPORTS

Monthly departmental reports are provided for the Board's review and information. These reports highlight departmental activities, accomplishments, service levels, and ongoing projects from the previous month.

Airport

The Louisa County Airport serves as an important transportation asset that supports economic development, business growth, tourism, and emergency services throughout the region.

Community Development

Community Development supports the County's growth and quality of life through planning, zoning, building permits, inspections, and code enforcement services.

Finance

The Finance Department is responsible for the County's financial management, including budgeting, accounting, financial reporting, purchasing, and fiscal oversight.

Fire-EMS

Louisa County Fire & EMS is dedicated to protecting the lives, property, and well-being of residents and visitors through emergency response, fire suppression, emergency medical services, fire prevention, and public education.

General Services

General Services is responsible for the maintenance and operation of County facilities, the landfill, convenience and recycling centers, and the Animal Shelter.

Human Resources

Human Resources supports the County's workforce through recruitment, employee relations, benefits administration, training, and organizational development.

Human Services

Human Services is committed to enhancing the quality of life for residents by connecting individuals and families with essential programs, resources, and support services.

Parks, Recreation & Tourism

Parks, Recreation, and Tourism enhances the quality of life for residents and visitors by providing recreational programs, maintaining parks and facilities, and promoting the County's unique attractions, history, and natural resources.

Sheriff's Office

Louisa County Sheriff's Office is dedicated to protecting the lives, property, and rights of residents through professional law enforcement, crime prevention, community engagement, and public safety services.

Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT)

VDOT is responsible for maintaining and improving the state-maintained roadways within Louisa County, supporting safe and reliable transportation for residents and visitors.

Water Authority

The Louisa County Water Authority provides reliable water and wastewater services that support public health, environmental stewardship, and economic growth throughout the County.
