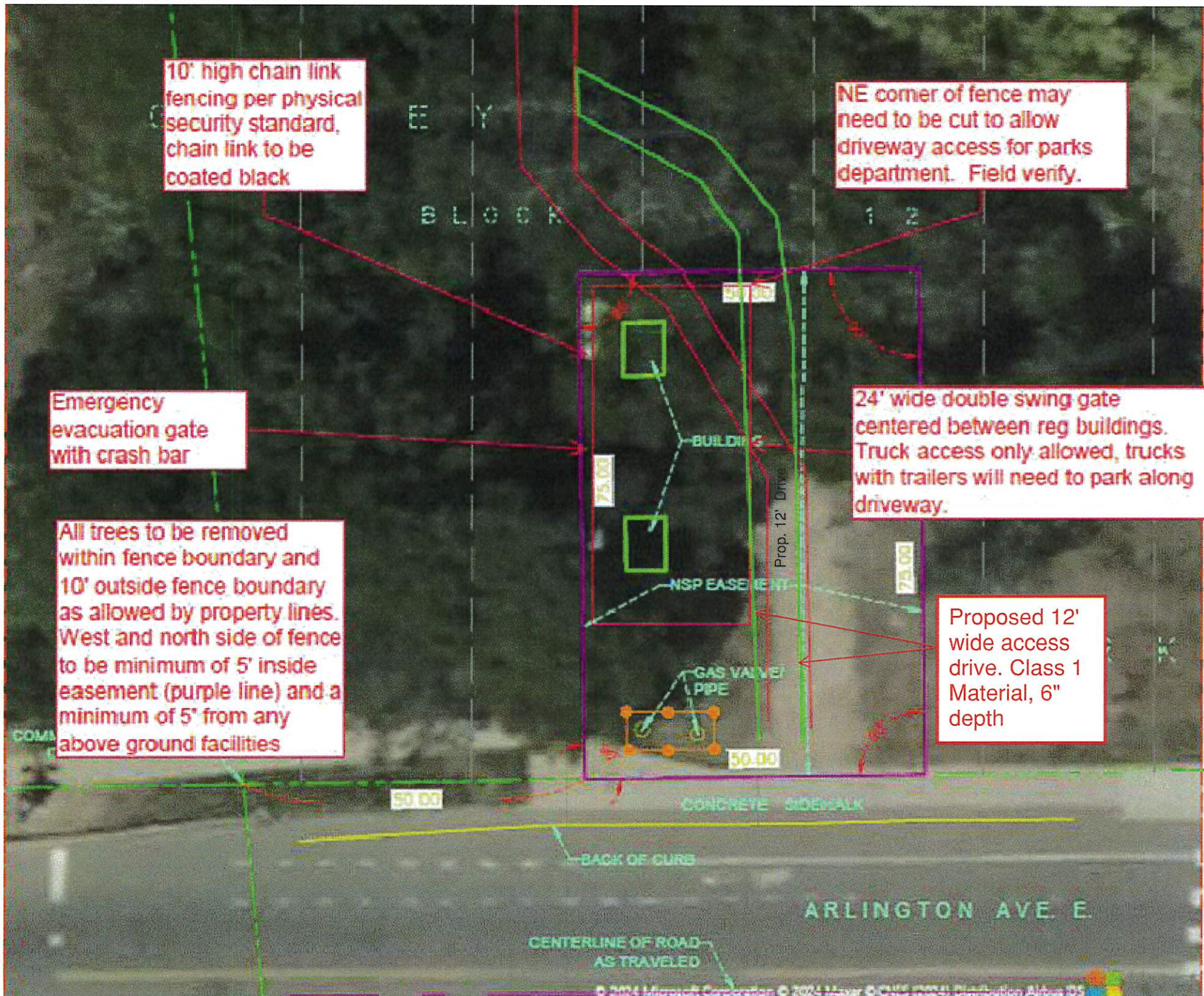

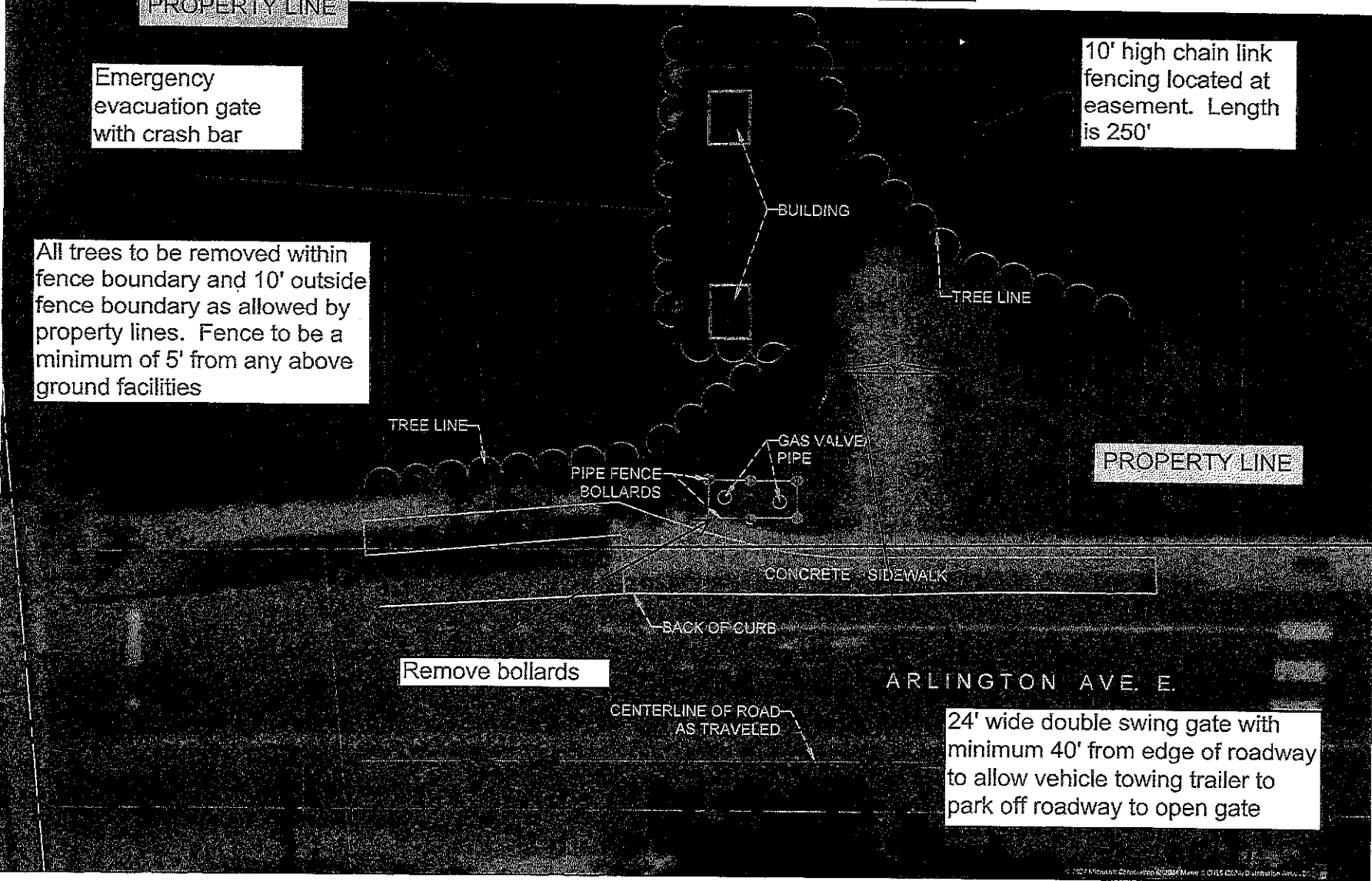

Onsite meeting Thu. 8/29, Brian Sullivan, Xcel Energy and Shawn O'Keefe, Jeff Strobel, City of Saint Paul.

Xcel Energy agrees to revise fence submittal. Sewer Utility has no further objections to the Xcel Energy proposed fence, after submittal is revised to include:

- A 45-degree cut on the northeast corner of the fence to facilitate city access to the Arlington-Jackson stormwater pond.
- Grading of a vehicle and equipment access path that is located to the north of the eastern fence line. The access path should be at least 12-ft in width.
- Removal of tree stumps in the access path.
- Placement of aggregate surfacing for the access path. Material used should be surface aggregate class 1, minimum of 6-in thick, and conforming to MnDOT spec 3138 Aggregate for Surface and Base Courses.

Next steps based review of earlier emails appears to be an Xcel Energy submittal of revised fence plan for review by City Real Estate and DSI.

Melissa and Brian,

Real Estate looked into the property rights and found the attached easement document from 1999. The City owns the property and granted Xcel (NSP) an easement for the regulator station and appurtenances (including fencing). Looking more closely at Xcel's drawings, we agree with the easement boundaries Xcel depicted, and it appears the proposed fence would be located within the easement area.

Public Works is certainly welcome to weigh in on Xcel's request to construct the fence, but Real Estate believes the easement gives Xcel the right to do so as long as they construct it within the existing easement area. The only outstanding issue is whether DSI will allow the fence to be built.

Melissa and Brian,

Let me give you a sense of the questions our Real Estate Section of the City's Office of Financial Services (not Public Works) is considering in connection with Xcel's fence request on city-owned land under the jurisdiction of Public Works.

- 1) The City needs to verify that we own the property, which we fully believe we do, but we want to be sure. Juan Ortiz from our Real Estate office is doing that now.
- 2) More important, the City needs to be clear whether Xcel already has an easement for the regulator station. If so, we would take that easement into account in considering whether to expand Xcel's easement footprint on the site. Juan is also looking for an easement, but we ask Xcel to check its records as well and send us any information regarding an existing easement.
- 3) While Real Estate is checking on property rights, another key step is to ask staff from our Public Works/Sewer Division to consider the fence request. The property is presumably being used for stormwater retention

purposes and the regulator station is on the perimeter of the site, so maybe erection of a fence around the station is not an issue, but our Public Works staff need to say for sure. I've copied them in this reply and included the drawings Xcel provide to our DSI staff. If they have any questions about the fence location or fence materials, they should reach out to Xcel directly.

- 4) If Xcel has easement rights to place the fence where they want, then the only issue is approval of a fence permit and/or fence variance. If Xcel does not have easement rights and Public Works does not wish to allow the construction of a fence on the property, it seems Xcel's fence request will not be approved. But if Xcel does not have easement rights and Public Works is comfortable with the fence construction, then Real Estate will need to work with Xcel to provide Xcel the necessary property rights, which in Real Estate's view should include the following steps:
- a. Legal description and depiction of the easement area
 - b. Determination of the length of the easement term (presumably perpetual)
 - c. Valuation of the easement area
 - d. Codification of the easement on a written document signed by the City and approved by the City Council
 - e. Payment for the easement rights by Xcel

Let me know if you have any questions about the above items. In the meantime, I would ask our Public Works staff to consider the request and reply to this group. Likewise, Real Estate staff will be looking into existing or needed property rights and get back to everyone.

Hi Brian,

I saw that the building official denied the fence variance – which makes sense, he denies most of them because he sees the power to approve/deny them as being up to City Council/the Legislative Hearing Officer (LHO). You can appeal his denial to the LHO of course, but first I would caution against going too far with the variance before we've got some other pieces figured out.

We've been in some discussions with the Real Estate Division in Public Works. We can't approve of a permit until we have their OK – I've cc'd Bruce Engelbrekt who works in that division. He mentioned he may need some time to research the property to figure things out with regards to property rights, easement(s), etc., since it's Public Work's land, we need their OK.

I just wanted to let you know before you were proceeding with any next steps with the height variance, so as not to give you the impression the variance is all we need for this.

Hi Brian,

We have an application for a 10' tall chainlink fence around this gas regulator. A few things before we proceed with review:

- I believe the address we're going to call this one is 63 Arlington Ave E, for your reference (we need to have an address for every permit and 63 Arlington is the one tied to that PIN number in our system). **Noted**
- This property is zoned H1 Residential. [Section 33.07\(c\)](#) states that "Fences for nonresidential uses in residential zoning districts must not exceed eight (8) feet in height" – so a 10 foot high fence would require a Fence Variance
 - If you want to proceed with the fence variance, please fill out and submit the fence variance form (not an 85.00 fee will be charged up front)
 - If you'd rather reduce the height to 8 feet to void the variance, please let me know
- Because this fence is over 7' in height it is a fence permit (same as a building permit) and not just a plan review. So when it's over 7 feet we then need to know and review more information on how the fence is constructed with regards to footings (depth, size, spacing) posts, gate, etc. – please provide more info on how the fence is to be constructed **Details of the fence are attached.**
- What style of gate is the 24' wide gate? Sliding, double swing, etc. - How does it open? We'd like to see this on the site plan to verify the gate won't swing especially over the property line, but also will the gate swing over the easement? **The gate is a swing gate and can swing inwards and outwards**
- Can you label the lineal feet of fencing on the site plan? I'm getting that it seems like it'd be more around 250-275 linear feet of fence rather than 375' but that's just me estimating based off a satellite image of the lot. **The fence is 250' in length**

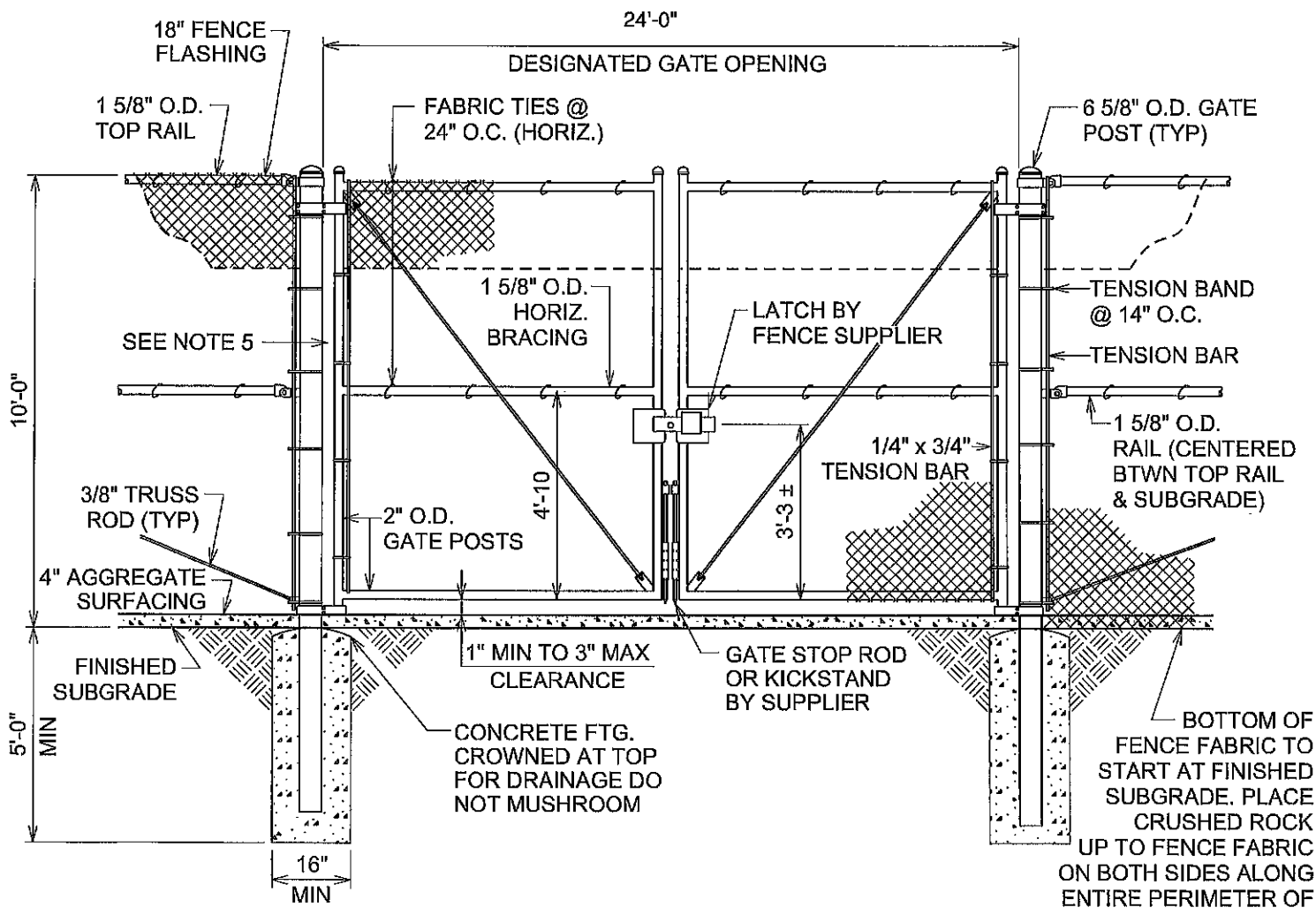

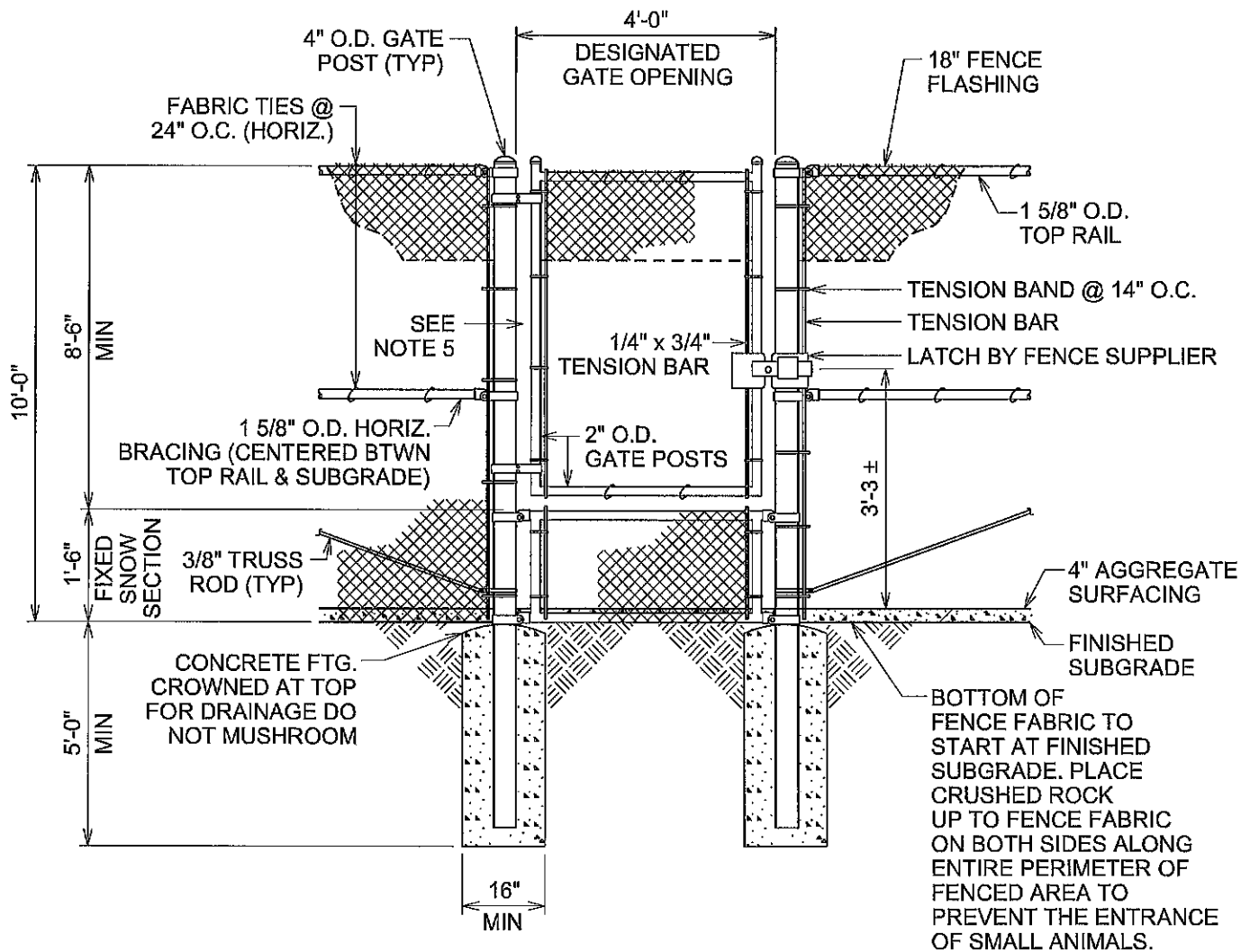
