1. CALL TO ORDER (PART 1 MINUTE 0:00:33)

The MPO Policy Board Chair, Ned Gallaway, presided and called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Gorjan Gjorgjievski called roll and read the notice of electronic meeting.

2. MATTERS FROM THE PUBLIC (PART 1 MINUTE 0:03:31)

Comments from the Public:

Peter Krebs, Danny Yoder, and Rory Stolzenberg spoke during public comment.

3. GENERAL ADMINISTRATION (PART 1: MINUTE 14:07)

Approval of the Agenda

Motion/Action: Ann Mallek made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Jen Fleisher seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Approval of March 20, 2026, Special Session Meeting Minutes

Motion/Action: Ann Mallek made a motion to approve the minutes. Natalie Oschrin seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

4. NEW BUSINESS

SMART SCALE Round 7 Projects Under Consideration (Part 1: Minute 16:15)

Taylor Jenkins presented the board with the Smart Scale Round 7 projects under consideration. The pre-application period has closed, and the full application period will begin on June 1. She gave a background on previous meetings and actions taken and not taken. She noted the recommended projects and those deferred for consideration by the MPO Technical Committee.

She noted the requested board actions for this meeting. She then briefly reviewed the projects that are under consideration for submission. She then presented the next steps and timeline for the application process.

Motion/Action: Ann Mallek made a motion to adopt the resolution endorsing the submission of the Smart Scale application for projects submitted by Albemarle County within the urbanized area for Round 7 as described. Natalie Oschrin seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Motion/Action: Natalie Oschrin made a motion to adopt the resolution endorsing the submission of the Smart Scale application for projects submitted by the City of Charlottesville within the urbanized area for Round 7 as described. Jen Fleisher seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Motion/Action: Ann Mallek made a motion to adopt the resolution endorsing CA-MPO's Smart Scale application for the I-64/Fifth Street Interchange project. Natalie Oschrin seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Motion/Action: Ann Mallek made a motion to adopt the resolution endorsing CA-MPO's Smart Scale application for the US 29 NB/250 EB Ramp Extension Barracks Road Off-Ramp project. Jen Fleisher seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Motion/Action: Ann Mallek made a motion to adopt the resolution endorsing CA-MPO's Smart Scale application for the Old Ivy Road On-ramp/Leonard Sandridge Road Off-ramp Auxiliary Lane Ramp project. Ned Gallaway seconded.

(Discussion began at Part 1 Minute 33:00)

Motion/Action: The motion was restated from above. The motion passed 3-2.

Motion/Action: Ann Mallek made a motion to adopt the resolution endorsing CA-MPO's Smart Scale application for the US29/250 SB Off-ramp extension at Old Ivy Road project. Ned Gallaway seconded.

(Discussion began at Part 1 Minute 50:50)

Motion/Action: The motion passed 3-2.

FY27 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) (Part 2 Minute 0:11)

Taylor Jenkins presented the final draft of the MPO's FY27 UPWP. She briefly covered the updates since the first draft including updates in budgets and task activities.

Ned Gallaway opened the public hearing.

There were no comments.

The public hearing was closed.

Motion/Action: Ann Mallek made a motion to approve the CAMPO FY27 UPWP. Jen Fleisher seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

FY27-FY30 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) (Part 2 Minute 7:40)

Gorjan Gorgjievski presented the FY27-30 TIP giving key updates in the document. (This presentation is in the agenda packet.) He showed the summary table of the funding of the VDOT projects. There has not been any public feedback on the TIP to date.

Ned Gallaway opened the public hearing.

There were no comments.

The public hearing was closed.

Motion/Action: Natalie Oschrin made a motion to adopt the FY27-FY30 TIP as presented. Jen Fleisher seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

FY24-FY27 TIP Amendment #14 and Adjustment #27 (Part 2 Minute 13:00)

Gorjan Gorgjievski gave a summary of Amendment #14 and the funds for that project. There have been no comments from the public about this change.

He continued sharing the adjustment to item #27. This item does not require action from the board.

Ned Gallaway opened the public hearing for amendment #14. No comments. Public hearing was closed.

Motion/Action: Natalie Oschrin made a motion to approve the TIP amendment #14. Ann Mallek seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Ann Mallek left the meeting.

CA-MPO Bylaws and Public Engagement Plan Revisions (Part 2 Minute 19:40)

Following action at the February Policy Board meeting to sunset the Citizens Transportation Advisory Committee (CTAC), Taylor Jenkins presented proposed revisions to the CA-MPO Technical Committee Bylaws, Policy Board Bylaws, and CA-MPO Engagement Plan. No action was required at this meeting.

Ned Gallaway left the meeting and Natalie Oschrin, Vice Chair, took over as chair of the meeting.

5. STAFF UPDATES (PART 2: MINUTE 24:30)

A written staff update was included in the meeting packet that covered Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A), the April Commonwealth Transportation Board meeting topics, TJPDC renovations, and more.

6. VDOT PROJECT UPDATES (PART 2 MINUTE 26:27)

STARS and Pipeline Studies Update

Sandy Shackelford said the studies are moving along. VDOT is planning to transition the Interchange at 118 Pipeline project into a larger phase 2 STARS study that will begin later in the year. Regarding the US29 corridor and interchange projects, moving forward with finalizing alternatives to advance for public review and there is an upcoming stakeholder meeting scheduled. She also stated that the Pipeline studies are moving along and they have what they need for the DDI, just waiting on a few pieces of updated technical information. Ms. Shackelford said they are in good shape for the Smart Scale application.

Discussion was held on the Emmet Street Streetscape project and Natalie Oschrin highlighted the new Virginia Breeze east-west route.

7. ADDITIONAL MATTERS FROM THE PUBLIC (PART 2: MINUTE 31:20)

Rory Stolzenberg provided additional public comments.

Sean Nelson said it is Work zone Awareness Week. The motto is "Safe Actions Save Lives."

Jen Fleisher asked who to contact about making the Smart Scale process and agenda item. Ms. Jenkins said to reach out to her.
